PATIENT INSTURCTIONS REGARDING GLUCOPHAGE, GLOCOVANCE or METFORMIN USE PRE AND POST CONSTRAT INJECTION

You have or will receive an IV contrast for the purpose of completing your radiology exam. The contrast can interact with Glucophage and affect your kidney function. Because of the possible interaction, you need to do the following:

- 1. We need a current serum Creatinine. (Current within 30 days of the examination.)
- 2. The day of your exam and for 48 hours following your exam DO NOT TAKE YOUR GLUCOPHAGE, GLOCOVANCE or METFORMIN. Following your exam, a repeat lab test for Creatinine must be reviewed and approved by your physician before you can start your Glucophage, Glocovance or Metformin again.
